EVA Junior Fellows Network for international students, researchers and young graduates was launched in 2003. The aim of the network is to build partnerships between young talents and the Finnish business community. EVA selects every year about 25 new Junior Fellows for a period of two years. Junior Fellows are invited to a two-day seminar, which is organised in Helsinki at the end of August every year. The seminar provides the Junior Fellows a possibility to exchange ideas with Finnish business leaders and experts from different sectors.

We search for 18-28 year-old young people with

- Talent:
 - Students (graduate and post-graduate), researchers and young professionals with exceptional resumes.
 - Young opinionated people who like to discuss and debate.
- International perspective on the world:
 - International Finns residing abroad and non-Finns residing in Finland or abroad who have an interest in business, economics and/or social sciences.
- Interest in the Finnish business community and society.

We offer:

- A two-day seminar in Helsinki at the end of August in 2011. The seminar provides the participants a chance to learn more about Finnish corporations, society and culture and to engage in discussions with other Junior Fellows as well as with top Finnish leaders.
- An active and international network of young talented people. The Junior Fellows Network consists of already over 170 people from all around the world.
- A possibility to contribute to EVA's activities e.g. by exchanging ideas and writing articles to EVA's website.
- A possibility to keep in touch with the Finnish business community and society.

What is EVA?

The Finnish Business and Policy Forum EVA (known by its Finnish acronym EVA) is a think tank founded in 1974. EVA is funded by key business organisations in Finland and it is independent of government and political parties. EVA's mission is to promote discussion about key national and international issues. EVA is a discussion forum and networking arena for decision-makers both in business and society. EVA publishes reports, organises debates and publishes policy proposals. EVA works in close co-operation with the Research Institute of the Finnish Economy ETLA - the two organisations share the same Board and Managing Director.

EVA in action

EVA's task is to identify and evaluate trends that are important for Finnish companies and the society as a whole. Violent and rapid international phenomena impose serious demands on society and business activity. EVA aims to provide current information on prevailing trends and to bring fresh ideas to public debate. EVA creates discussion in the society by publishing articles, reports, policy papers; by holding debates called EVA Forums and EVA Symposiums; by organising seminars and by maintaining an EVA Fellows network which consists of EVA Fellows, Business Fellows, Junior Fellows and the international counterpart organisations.
