Registration

All international undergraduates are eligible to apply for the programme but must possess a good command of English language as the programme will be conducted in English.

Please submit your application form either by email to cce@ntu.edu.sg or via fax to (+65)6774 2911. You are required to submit a letter from your university verifying your student status.

You will receive an email acknowledgement within 2 working days from your registration. If you do not receive any acknowledgement from us, please send an email to cce@ntu.edu.sg.

The early bird registration & payment deadline is <u>20 April 2011</u>. The standard registration & payment deadline is <u>10 May 2011</u>. Registration after the deadline will not be accepted.

The programme may not run if there are insufficient participants. Full refund will be made if the programme is cancelled.

You will be notified on the final confirmation of your application and the status of the programme by 20 May 2011.

Certificate

NTU will issue a Certificate of Attendance to participants who achieved at least 75% attendance. Academic credits will not be awarded by NTU but home universities may consider awarding credit to their own students.



Insurance

You are required to purchase travel insurance to cover your stay in Singapore. Proof of purchase of travel insurance must be submitted to NTU prior to your arrival. You will not be able to participate in the programme if you do not comply with this requirement

Entry to Singapore

Please refer to the Singapore Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) website http://www.ica.gov.sg/index.aspx to check if you require Visa to enter Singapore.

If you need to apply for Visa, please indicate in the application form so that we can send you an invitation letter and <u>Letter of Introduction for Visa Application (Form V39A)</u> to facilitate your visa application. Please arrange your own visa application and if you need any assistance, please check with our Singapore Mission/consular at your home country.

Accommodation

Twin-sharing student hostel accommodation (fully air-conditioned) will be provided at NTU main campus during the programme period.

Check-in: 13 July 2011 (Wednesday), 12noon to 8pm

Check-out: 27 July 2011 (Wednesday), 8.30am to 12 noon.

Remarks:

- * No extension of stay is allowed and you have to adhere strictly to the check-in/check-out timing.
- * A CASH deposit of SGD 100 is required upon checking in. The deposit will be fully refunded upon checking-out if there are no damages to the hostel room.
