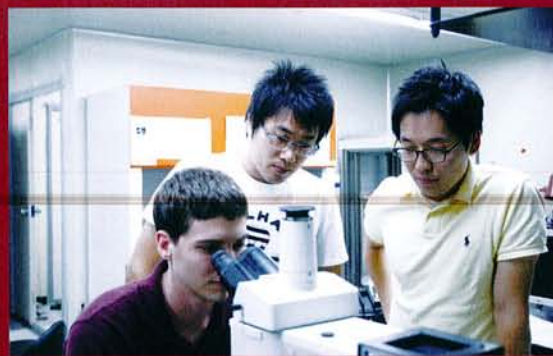


Summer at POSTECH

EXPENSES

- Housing: KRW 400,000/Program (Meals not included.)
- Korean Language Program: KRW 100,000/Program*
- * When students complete the program, they will be reimbursed.
- Health Insurance: All students must purchase their own insurance.

SCHOLARSHIP

Students participating in research will receive a monthly stipend.

- Undergraduate students: KRW 250,000
- Graduate students: KRW 300,000
