The University of Navarra was founded in 1952. It offers 32 degree programs, 10 double degree programs, 9 bilingual programs, 33 master's programs, and 33 doctoral programs.

The main campus is located in Pamplona, where 13 Schools are based. Also in Pamplona are the University Clinic, the Center for Applied Medical Research (CIMA) and the Institute of Culture and Society.

The University of Navarra has another campus in San Sebastián as well as the IESE Business School campuses in Barcelona, Madrid and New York.

## NAVARRRE & PAMPLONA

The main campus of the University of Navarra is located in the region of Navarre, in northern Spain. Navarre is a place of great beauty, bordered by the Pyrenees and the rich Rioja vineyards. Known for its natural resources and its rich cultural history, Navarre is part of the medieval Way of St. James, which is a map of all the heritage, tradition and spirituality of European peoples. It is one of the wealthiest regions in Spain, and also one of the "greenest" regions in Europe, an international leader in recycling and renewable energy.

Pamplona is the capital of Navarre. It is a city with beautiful parks, and narrow winding streets whose many cafés, shops and restaurants bustle with local people and visitors. Pamplona is world famous for the San Fermín festival ("Sanfermines") which precedes the International Summer University dates.

All other courses: English (intermediate level).
