Taking full advantage of its location at the George Washington University's Elliott School of International Affairs in downtown Washington, DC, the program features briefings at key institutions that influence U.S. foreign policy, as well as lectures and seminars by leading scholars and experts from government offices, think tanks, international organizations, nonprofit organizations, the media, and foreign embassies.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The U.S. Foreign Policy Summer Program will offer two, two-week courses in the summer of 2013. The programs, which are offered for academic credit or audit, feature core lectures by the program director, GW faculty, and guest speakers from a wide variety of organizations.
