## Programme Outline

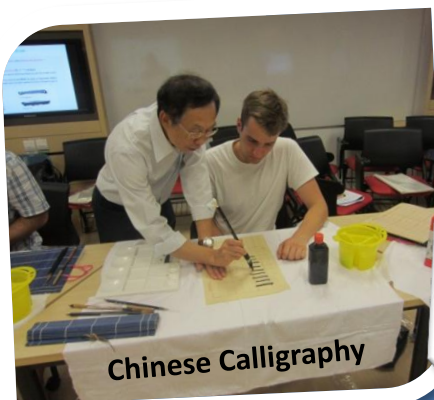
### Chinese Language Courses

### Chinese Culture Courses

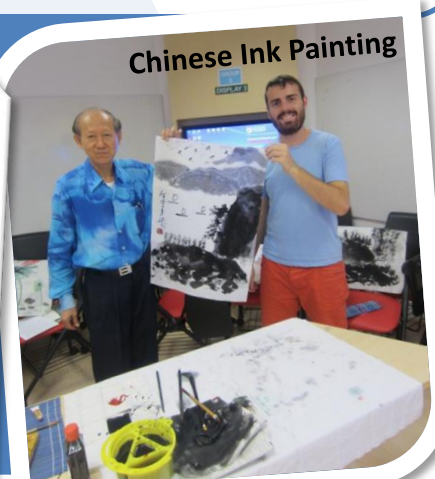
- Cultural immersion activities allows you to better appreciate Chinese culture
