 - a. Please set out in your own words why UNSW should support your nomination to the institution.
 - *b.* Please describe your proposed research area for the conference and any courses that you have completed at UNSW that relate to it.
 - *c.* What do you intend to bring back from your short course experiences that will add value to UNSW, yourself and other students?
- 3. A resume outlining any relevant achievements or work experience.
- 4. A copy of the ID page of your passport.
- 5. Your current Academic Statement from www.my.unsw.edu.au.

Students nominated to participate in the above program are expected to submit a testimonial on their experiences at the end of their program.

- If applicable, students MUST speak to their UNSW Faculty about their proposed study plan and negotiate any transfer of credit issues with their Faculty *before* submitting an application to the Global Education Office.
